For Pantry use:

Receive food assistance every 30 days.

Current proof of residency-utility or phone bill each month

Current proof of income each month *

Social Security Cards first time only for each household member.

Seniors age 60 or above

1. "Fit for life" Exercise Class at Lakeview Terrace Apartments-Tues. 9am to 11am, class taught by our Outreach Nurse from Pro-Health.

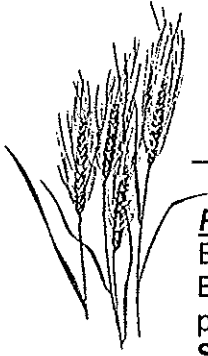
Outreach nurse, Blood pressure checks/chair exercises/Yoga/resource for dental/vision and obtaining medications.

2. Stockbox Program/ Commodity Supplemental Food Program

3. Seniors on the Go Taxi Service-seniors and disabled persons/ 363-5700

4. Seniors Farmer's Market Nutrition Program-Monthly income of \$1670 or less
Receive \$25.00 in vouchers/one per household/good till 10/31/10 at participating Farmers Markets.

Have several shower chairs, elevated toilet seats and free standing commodes.
