

TOWN OF EAGLE
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 27, 2006
MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Present: Gillette, Malek, Kwiatkowski, West. Orchard @7:55 p.m. Numerous residents from the Town and Village were also present.

Groundwater Flow Report- Ken Bradbury, Hydrogeologist from Wisconsin Geological & Natural History Survey Unit of the University of Wisconsin Extension, and Michael Hahn, Chief Environmental Engineer with the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission were present to explain details regarding the report on shallow groundwater flow in the vicinity of the Village of Eagle's municipal wells on CTH LO. The results of this report will also be made available online at SEWRPC's website. It was explained that the report was based on a computerized groundwater model in order to evaluate impacts of the recently installed municipal wells operated by the Village. The impact area covered in the model included properties in the Town of Eagle and portions of nearby watersheds of Lake Lulu, Eagle Spring Lake, Jericho Creek, upper Scuppernong River, and upper Mukwonago River. The model predicted that the water levels near the wells would drop approximately five feet. A question and answer period followed the presentation to address citizens' inquiries and concerns.

At the conclusion of the informational meeting, a motion was made by Gillette, seconded by West to adjourn at 9:43 p.m. Motion carried.
