Got Buckthorn? Frustrated with Garlic Mustard? Loathe Honeysuckle? Now is your chance to fight back and receive financial assistance from Friends of the Mukwonago River! We helped landowners manage almost 50 acres of invasive removal and restoration over the past few years. This grant will run through June 30, 2021. All work and grant funds must be expended by that date.
