## GENERAL INFORMATION

#### ABOUT

The Town and Village of Eagle Recreation Department is committed to meeting the current and future community needs by offering quality, safe, and affordable programs to all Town and Village of Eagle and surrounding area residents.

The Eagle Recreation Department was formed in 2002. It is funded by the Town and Village of Eagle. Since 2002, soccer and baseball have been enjoyed by more than 200 children per season. We have added yoga, craft classes, senior events, Pickle Ball, basketball, family events, and much more! We are continually looking for ways to generate income to subsidize costs. We greatly appreciate donations to our programs from residents and businesses. Anyone interested in making a donation can contact our office at 262-949-4232.

The Town and Village of Eagle Boards govern the Recreation Department Committee. The Committee is comprised of one member from the Village Board, one member from the Town Board, one village resident, one town resident, and the Director of the Eagle Recreation Department. Their respective Boards appoint members. The Recreation Committee will be directly responsible for all Eagle Recreation decisions involving budget, expenditures of funds, policies, and programs offered by the Eagle Recreation Department. The Eagle Recreation Department Committee is also responsible for the direct supervision of the Recreation Director.

### FAGLE TOWN PARK & PASTERSKI PAVILION

The Eagle Town Park has playground equipment, soccer fields, baseball diamonds, and lacrosse fields. We have 1 pavilion available for rent starting at \$ 100 (based on number of attendees), plus a security deposit. Renter's will have access to a kitchen and restroom facilities on site. Renters must supply all paper goods and garbage bags.

### EAGLE VILLAGE PARK & PAVILION

The Eagle Village Park has playground equipment, soccer fields, baseball diamonds, horseshoe pits, tennis courts, pickleball courts, and volleyball courts. We have 3 pavilions available for rent for \$100 rental fee, plus \$100 deposit. Renter's will have access to both the large Pavilion/shelter and the small pavilion, which holds the kitchen (no Stove). There are restroom facilities on site. Renters must supply all paper goods and garbage bags.















Registration deadlines are set by the leagues in order to coordinate the number of teams for each community and schedule/coordinate the games, refs, order shirts, equipment, and prepare the fields. Late registrations cause overcrowding of teams or kids to miss out on an opportunity to play with their friends and neighbors. Early registration is always accepted. For Youth sports, please complete the Youth Registration form, you may put multiple sports or children on the same form. Payment may be made with check, cash, or online.

Every attempt is made to accommodate special requests for coaches and teammates, but team sizes and early requests will be given preference. Most communication is made via email. Please be sure to make Eaglerecreation@townofeaglewi.us a trusted sender to ensure you are receiving emails. It is your responsibility to reach out if you have not heard received any communication.

Inclement weather is determined by the coach and players. If a coach decides to cancel a game, it is the two coaches responsibility to reschedule for another date and time. Notification of the new agreed upon date should be sent to the home team director ASAP in order to get Refs lined up for the game.


