TOWN OF EAGLE WAUKESHA COUNTY, WI ORDINANCE NO 2024-05

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE LITTLE PRAIRIE ROAD FROM THE WAUKESHA COUNTY LINE ON THE SOUTH TO COUNTY HIGHWAY NN ON THE NORTH AS A "CLASS B" HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, Section 349.15(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes provides that, except with regard to a highway which is a state trunk highway or a connecting highway, the Town Board may designate all of any part of a highway maintained by it as a "Class B" highway and thereby impose the weight limitations set forth in Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes on such highway; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Eagle, having responsibility for the maintenance of Little Prairie Road in the Town of Eagle, finds that the designation of said Little Prairie Road as a Class B highway is necessary to promote the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board for the Town of Eagle, County of Waukesha, Wisconsin, do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: DESIGNATION OF LITTLE PRAIRIE ROAD AS A "CLASS B" HIGHWAY.

Pursuant to Section 349.15(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, Little Prairie in the Town of Eagle is hereby designated as a Class B highway and shall be subject to the weight limitations imposed by Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

SECTION 2: VIOLATIONS.

Except as permitted under Section 348.16(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, any person violating the Class B weight limits pertaining to Little Prairie Road under Section 348.16 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to the penalty provisions as set forth in Sections 348.20 and 348.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and as amended from time-to-time, which are adopted herein and incorporated by reference.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section of portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof in the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
